NOTICE OF INJURY PURSUANT TO SECTION 893.80(1)(a), WIS. STATS.


Please be advised that we have been retained by and represent the Estate of Joyce Richter, Brent Richter, Scott Richter, Bob Richter and Robin Welter, with regard to injuries, damages and wrongful death sustained by Joyce Richter as a result of falls she had on November 30, 2015 at approximately 6:45 p.m. and 10:50 pm. As a result of the fall on November 30, 2015 at 10:50 p.m. she suffered injuries, including but not limited to, facial injuries, bruising to her face and nose and hematoma to her forehead. After 10:50 p.m. she started to experience a headache and worsening of the facial bruising and swelling. These changes in her condition were not reported to her doctor and Power of Attorney for Healthcare (POAHC). Her doctor and POAHC were finally notified of her headache and worsened facial bruising and swelling on 12/1/15 at 10:45 am. Her doctor ordered her to be sent to the hospital. She was diagnosed with an acute subdural hematoma, facial contusions and closed fracture of the nasal bone. She died on December 14, 2015 due to complications of the closed head injury she suffered in the fall on November 30, 2015 at 10:50 p.m. This Notice of Injury is served upon the City of Kenosha by Brent Richter individually, and on behalf of the Estate of his mother, Joyce Richter, and by Scott Richter, Bob Richter and Robin Welter

Our investigation reveals that Brookside and its agents, employees and representatives did not provide reasonable and adequate care and treatment to Joyce Richter, including but not limited to, developing and implementing an adequate Plan of Care to protect Joyce and ensure Joyce's safety, provide the necessary supervision and assistance to prevent falls, notify her medical doctor and POAHC of acute changes in her condition after hitting her head in the fall of November 30, 2105 at 10:50, and follow policies and procedures and state and federal nursing home regulations. She was left unattended which directly resulted in a preventable fall and fatal brain injury which caused her death and was a proximate cause of the loss of society and companionship sustained by Brent Richter, Scott Richter, Bob Richter and Robin Welter, and the injuries,

death, medical bills and funeral expenses sustained by Joyce Richter/the Estate of Joyce Richter.

This Notice of Injury is provided to the City of Kenosha pursuant to Section 893.80(1)(a), Wis. Stats. Please send a written acknowledgement of this Notice of Injury. The undersigned is one of the attorneys for the Estate of Joyce Richter and Brent Richter, Scott Richter, Bob Richter and Robin Welter and is, therefore, authorized to give this Notice of Injury.
