Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Report on Second Quarter Federal Housing Revenue:

6:33: Fiscal Manager, Nancy Otis, prepared and sent a report for all Committee Members. The report provides data by month, with an as of June 30, year to date surplus in housing, of \$561,873.20.

Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Memo Request for Special Assignment Wage – Corrections Supervisors:

6:34: Bob Reidl attended the meeting to answer questions. Reidl stated that because Judiciary & Law is the oversight committee for the Sheriff's Department, they were sharing this information even though it only needs to go to Finance. Unusually high vacancies in corrections has created a significant number of involuntary assigned overtime shifts. This will allow correctional supervisors to work these shifts, and not force CO/DSO's. Supervisors would not be allowed to sign up for an overtime shift and take away the opportunity from a corrections CO or DSO who wishes to work overtime. Pay would be at one and a half times the top corrections officer wage, or \$37.28/hour. This would extend through the end of the year. This would be going to Finance the next week and does not have to go to the full County Board.

Any Other Business Allowed by Law: 6:39: Reidl reported that the extra pay was given to correctional officers on 7/24 and that they are now hiring at the higher rate.
