Work Starting on the South Segment of the Kenosha County Bicycle/Pedestrian Trail in the Village of Pleasant Prairie

Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser announces the beginning of work on the South Segment of the Kenosha County Bicycle/Pedestrian Trail located between 89th Street and the Illinois border in the Village of Pleasant Prairie. The project will begin on Monday September 12, 2011. The Bicycle/Pedestrian Trail will be closed to public use during working hours for the duration of the project.

The Kenosha County Division of Highways will be completing the work on the project. The estimated cost of the project is \$440,000 and will be funded 50% by Kenosha County and 50% by a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

The project involves construction of a 10-foot wide asphalt path for the entire length of the project. Additionally, improvements will be made to accommodate trail use by individuals with disabilities. Improvements including signing and pavement markings will be made at all road crossings. All work associated with the project is anticipated to be completed this fall. However, landscape finishing may carryover until spring of 2012.
